## **DAY 1 October 29 TRANSATLANTIC FLIGHT TO TEL AVIV**

Today we depart from the USA to Tel Aviv, Israel. Meals served in flight.

## **DAY 2 October 30 ARRIVE IN ISRAEL**

Arrive at Ben Gurion International Airport in Tel Aviv and transfer to our hotel in the Galilee area for check in, dinner and a good night's sleep.

## **DAY 3 October 31 CAESAREA PHILLIPPI / DAN / GOLAN HEIGHTS / JORDAN RIVER**

After our delicious buffet breakfast, journey to Caesarea Philippi, where Peter proclaimed, "You are the Christ" (Matthew 16). You will also visit the ancient remains of Tel Dan and the altar built by King Jeroboam I (I Kings 12). Travel through portions of the Golan Heights to gain a better understanding of its strategic importance to the nation of Israel. End the day with a stop at the Jordan River for a time of spiritual blessing.

## **DAY 4 November 1 NAZARETH VILLAGE / CANA / FISH LUNCH / BOAT RIDE / CAPERNAUM / MT. OF BEATITUDES / ST. PETER'S PRIMACY**

This morning we explore the Nazareth Village, a living presentation of the life, times, and teachings of Jesus of Nazareth. Recall Jesus' first miracle as you pass through Cana (John 2). Enjoy a fish lunch at Ein Gev Kibbutz. Afterwards, enjoy a beautiful boat ride across the Sea of Galilee. Enter the 2,000 year old remains of Capernaum (Luke 4) and stand in what is left of the synagogue in which our Lord ministered. Visit the traditional site where Jesus preached His Sermon on the Mount (Matt. 5-7). Stop at the Chapel of the Primacy, where Peter confessed his devotion to Christ 3 times (John 21).



## **DAY 5 November 2 MEGIDDO / MT. CARMEL / CAESAREA BY THE SEA / WESTERN WALL**

Travel the ancient caravan route to Tel Megiddo where 20 different cities lie superimposed upon each other. Look out over the Valley of Jezreel from the heights of Mount Carmel. Wonder at the Roman Aqueduct and Hippodrome at Caesarea, a center of the early Christians. Here, Cornelius became the first Gentile convert to the new covenant (Acts 10) and Paul was imprisoned before taken to Rome for trial (Acts 23). Our journey now takes us to the 'Golden City' of Jerusalem. End this memorable day with a visit to the Western Wall before transferring to your Jerusalem hotel for dinner and overnight.

## **DAY 6 November 3 SHILOH / ST. PETER IN GALLICANTU CHURCH / PILATE'S JUDGMENT HALL / LITHOSTROTOS / VIA DOLOROSA**

This morning we visit Shiloh before traveling on to St. Peter in Gallicantu. This site is thought to be the House of Caiaphas who was the High Priest at the time of our Lord's trial and crucifixion. Visit the Lithostrotos and see the area of pavement constructed with large slabs which is associated with the condemnation of Jesus by Pilate. (John 19) The pavement also has a Roman "King's Game" board carved to use for a dice game into it that recalls the casting of lots for Jesus' clothing after His crucifixion (John 19). Finally, walk the Via Dolorosa, "the Way of the Cross".

## **DAY 7 November 4 MODEL CITY / UPPER ROOM / JEWISH QUARTER / WALK THE WALL / TEMPLE MOUNT / POOL OF BETHESDA / MT. OF OLIVES / GARDEN OF GETHSEMANE / DOMINUS FLEUIT / CITY OF DAVID**

This morning we will visit the remarkable Model City of Jerusalem, shown as it was during the Roman occupation which will help us understand what the city looked like during the time of our Lord. Stand in the Upper Room, revered as the place of the Last Supper (Mark 14). Walk through the Jewish Quarter, where modern buildings tower over excavations that date to the Judean Monarchy. Continue your walk along the Walls of the City of Jerusalem. See the Temple Mount, once the site of the Temple of Solomon. View the Pool of Bethesda (John 5: 1-31) where Jesus performed the Sabbath miracle. Stand atop the Mount of Olives as Jesus did and enjoy a remarkable view of the "Golden City" of Jerusalem. Forty days after His resurrection, Jesus ascended into heaven from the Mount of Olives (Acts 1: 9-12). Pray in the Garden of Gethsemane amongst Olive Trees in the Kidron Valley across from the walls of Jerusalem. At Dominus Fleuit Church, which means the cry of the Lord, you will visit the place where Jesus mourned for Jerusalem as He spoke these words, "the days will come upon you when your enemies will... dash you to the ground." (Luke 19:41.). Wander through the excavations of the City of David.



**DAY 8 November 5 SAPIR PARK / MASADA / DEAD SEA / VALLEY OF THE SHADOW**

Travel south to Sapir Park, a 'leafy' Oasis in the middle of the wilderness (Isaiah 35). Visit Masada, the spectacular mountaintop fortress built by Herod. Masada is famous as being the last stronghold of the Jewish Rebellion against the Romans. Ride the cable car to the top to explore the fortress. Peer down upon the 2,000 year old remains of the Roman camps and siege ramp below. While in the area, we will stop at the Dead Sea where those who desire may feel its salt and mineral laden waters. As we make our way back to Jerusalem, we will pass through the Judean Wilderness paralleling the ancient Roman road to view the Valley of the Shadow. From here, you can see St. George's Monastery across the gorge.

**DAY 9 November 6 DAVIDSON'S VISITOR CENTER / SOUTHERN WALL ARCHAEOLOGICAL GARDEN / RABBI'S TUNNEL / YAD VASHEM / GARDEN TOMB / GORDON'S CALVARY**

Visit the Davidson Center and the Southern Wall Excavations including the Teaching Steps and the Western Wall. Follow the Herodian Support Wall and walk on First Century pavement in the Rabbi's Tunnel. Visit the Yad Vashem Holocaust Memorial and be touched by its poignant images. Visit and worship at the Garden Tomb, possible site of the garden of Joseph of Arimathea and experience the reality of the resurrection. At the end of our time in the Holy Land, we prepare for our return journey back to the USA.

**DAY 10 November 7 ARRIVE USA**

Arrive in the USA with a lifetime of memories to cherish.
